1. Call to Order (Stu Glass, Chair)

Stu Glass, Chair, called the meeting to order at 9:01 AM.

2. Agenda Revisions (Stu Glass, Chair)

There were no agenda revisions.

3. Minutes Approval (Stu Glass, Chair)

Requested Action: Approval of Minutes from Finance Subcommittee meeting on August 2, 2022.

MOTION WAS MADE BY TOM CAMPENNI TO APPROVE THE MEETING MINUTES FROM AUGUST 2, 2022. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY GREG WILSON. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

4. Public Comment

5. New Business

- a. Approve consultant services identified via RFQ to develop an IRLNEP strategy (FY 2023-FY 2026)

Dr. De Freese discussed the need to contract a consultant to address Justice, Equity Diversity, and Inclusion (JEDI) issues in alignment with USEPA guidance and funded through the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA).

Requested Action: Authorize staff to negotiate and enter into a contract with *Diversity of Thought, Inc.* to provide professional services to the IRLNEP staff and program activities. The contract term would be 3 years with the option for 2 additional years pursuant to funding availability.

MOTION WAS MADE BY TOM CAMPENNI TO RECOMMEND TO THE MANAGEMENT BOARD THAT THE IRL COUNCIL BOARD OF DIRECTORS AUTHORIZE STAFF TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH DIVERSITY OF THOUGHT, INC. TO PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES TO THE IRLNEP STAFF AND PROGRAM ACTIVITIES. THE CONTRACT TERM WOULD BE 3 YEARS WITH AN OPTION FOR 2 ADDITIONAL YEARS

PURSUANT TO FUNDING AVAILABILITY. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY STU GLASS. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

b. FY 2023 Budget amendment, (Daniel Kolodny)

Mr. Kolodny reviewed and discussed the FY 2023 Resolution 2022-06. Financial adjustments to Other Expenditures, Salaries & Benefits, and Administrative Costs. The total increase is \$107,202.

Requested Action: Review and adopt the amended budget for FY 2023 by Resolution 2022-06. Pursuant to Florida Statutes.

MOTION WAS MADE BY TOM CAMPENNI TO RECOMMEND TO THE MANAGEMENT BOARD THAT THE IRL COUNCIL BOARD OF DIRECTORS APPROVE THE AMENDED BUDGET FOR FY 2023 BY RESOLUTION 2022-06. PURSUANT TO FLORIDA STATUTES. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY GREG WILSON. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

6. Member Reports

Greg Wilson observed from the Active Projects Report that Brevard County's sewer project has experienced significant delays. This has the potential to affect funding. Discussion occurred on the possibility of contract termination and using funds on other projects.

7. Final Comments (Committee, Staff, Public)

Dr. De Freese discussed Mr. Daniel Kolodny and his efforts to balance/juggle funds against the lack of released funds from the EPA, the funds were authorized one year ago and have not yet been received by the IRLNEP. The funds have been appropriated for the seagrass nursery projects. Discussion on the struggle with universities to obtain invoices to complete transactions, possible action could be placing a letter on file which would impact further partnerships. In seven years, 160 contracts have been fulfilled and one contract terminated.

BETWEEN THE IRL COUNCIL AND WOOD ENVIRONMENT &
INFRASTRUCTURE SOLUTIONS, INC. FOR INDIAN RIVER LAGOON
ATMOSPHERIC DEPOSITION OF NUTRIENTS MONITORING**

This **Amendment No. 1** to the General Services Agreement by and between the IRL Council and Wood Environment & Infrastructure Solutions, Inc. for Indian River Lagoon Atmospheric Deposition of Nutrients Monitoring is made as of the date last executed below, by and between the IRL Council (“Council”) and Wood Environment & Infrastructure Solutions, Inc. (“Contractor”) (hereinafter referred to as “Amendment No. 1”).

WHEREAS, the Contractor and the Council entered into the general services Agreement by and between the IRL Council and Wood Environment & Infrastructure Solutions, Inc. for Indian River Lagoon Atmospheric Deposition of Nutrients Monitoring on September 21, 2022 (the “Contract”); and

WHEREAS, the Contractor has changed its legal name to WSP USA ENVIRONMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE, INC.; and

WHEREAS, all prior references to WOOD Environment & Infrastructure Solutions Inc., shall be replaced with WSP USA ENVIRONMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE, INC.; and

WHEREAS, the Contractor requires additional funds to develop site designs and site overlays for the two (2) new atmospheric deposition sites to be located at the Canaveral National Seashore and Indian River Park; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to increase the total award under the Contract from \$29,000 to \$31,000; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to enter into this Amendment No. 1 to establish the changes to the Contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, the sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged by each party hereto, the Council and the Recipient agree to amend their Contract as follows:

1. **Recitals**. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
2. **Amendments**. The Contract is hereby amended as follows:
 - (a) The Contractor’s prior name of Wood Environment & Infrastructure Solutions, Inc. shall be substituted with WSP USA Environment & Infrastructure Inc.

wherever it appears in the contract. All rights and obligations of the parties under the Contract are unaffected by this change.

(b) Section 5 (Funding of Agreement) subsection (a) is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

(a) For satisfactory performance of the work for this term, the Council agrees to pay the Contractor a sum not to exceed \$31,000.

3. **Entire Agreement.** The Council and the Contractor agree that the Contract, and this Amendment No. 1 set forth the entire agreement between the parties, and that there are no promises or understandings other than those stated herein. None of the provisions, terms and conditions contained in this Amendment No. 1 may be added to, modified, superseded or otherwise altered, except by written instrument executed by the parties hereto. All other terms and conditions of the Contract remain in full force and effect.

4. **Counterparts.** This Amendment No. 1 may be simultaneously executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be an original and all of which shall constitute but one and the same instrument. Either or both parties may sign this Amendment No. 1 via facsimile or email and such signature is as valid as the original signature of such party.
